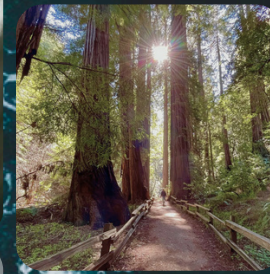

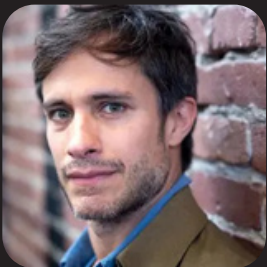
PAUL HAWKEN

BERTRAND PICCARD

Explorer and ecological pioneer, the first to fly around the world in a solar-powered airplane, demonstrating that it is possible to reinvent mobility and reduce dependence on fossil fuels.

One of the most recognized and respected environmental voices, whose pioneering work in conservation and nature protection has inspired millions.



KATE RAWORTH

Creator of the Doughnut Economics model, which proposes a new way to measure growth and prosperity without depleting the planet's resources.

NEMONTE NENQUIMO

Huaorani Indigenous leader from Ecuador and tireless defender of the Amazon, whose leadership was crucial in stopping oil exploitation on indigenous land through a historic referendum.



FERNANDO VALLADARES

Environmental scientist and communicator in Spain, recognized for his clear, data-driven explanations and as a key figure in promoting regenerative solutions.



ROB HOPKINS

Environmental activist and founder of the Transition Towns movement, which promotes the creation of sustainable and resilient communities through changes in the way we live.

This episode, led by **Rob Hopkins**—an “activist of imagination” and founder of a global movement of engaged citizens—explores the **significant changes we can achieve by applying regeneration to our farmland and cities:**

- Ernest Mas – a farmer who replaced pesticides with flowers and increased yields by regenerating the soil.
- The secret soil network – with Toby Kiers, the “Jane Goodall of fungi,” we delve into the fascinating underground ecosystem and its implications for climate and agriculture.
- The power of people – the child-led movement that transformed Amsterdam into a cycling and pedestrian paradise in the 1970s, told by one of its key protagonists, Maartje van Putten.
- The rise of the Transition Towns movement – through voices from Liège, who have revolutionized the city’s food system.
- Transformation to reclaim the soul of cities – led by Paris.

Transformation

This episode, featuring economist **Kate Raworth**—creator of the world’s most influential regenerative and circular economic model—explores **stories that can transform our cities, fields, and oceans, generating prosperity while cooling the planet:**

- The fisherman who brings life back to the sea – Bren Smith, who went from trawling to leading a movement of regenerative ocean farmers, cultivating seaweed to restore marine life.
- The marketer who got tired of making plastic look good – Julia Marsh, who shifted from advertising to leading ventures that replace plastic with regenerative seaweed.
- California’s compost revolution – a scientific breakthrough driving legislation to expand composting and cover agricultural fields with this “black gold.”
- Businesses cleaning the ocean as a way to do business – Atando Cabos collects fishing nets and weaves a new circular economy in Chile.

This episode dives into things that once flew under the radar but are now making a real difference—**technical innovations that work and are already reshaping the story**. We detect methane leaks from space, grow rice without flooding fields, and reinvent food from the molecular level. Because often, creativity is what transforms the world the most.

- Methane detectives – Itziar Irakuri tracks leaks from space, helping seal one of the climate’s biggest invisible wounds.
- Waterless rice – the SRI system multiplies yields and reduces emissions in India and Madagascar.
- Cow-free milk – Raffael Wohlgensinger (Formo) and precision fermentation are opening the door to a new food future.
- Soil under care – regenerative livestock practices and a new agricultural culture are spreading around the globe.

This episode journeys through the heart of the energy revolution and the global movement to restore nature. It's a **story of pioneers**, woven together by explorer Bertrand Piccard, whose solar-powered plane flew around the world—because “impossible” is just an opinion:

- A 100% renewable future—unstoppable – with Marc J. Jacobson, the world’s most influential scientist on the subject, and acclaimed thinker Tony Seba, showing how we can fully leave the fossil economy behind.
- Smart grids – inside Spain’s national grid control center, preparing for a giant leap: electrifying the economy with renewable energy.
- The solar and wind revolution – with Norah Magero, whose work tackles not only climate issues but also social, gender, and even nutrition challenges.
- The scientist who counted the Earth’s trees and sparked a global restoration – Tomas Crowther leads a worldwide movement placing farmers at the center of ecosystem restoration.

This final episode is **a portrait of the invisible forces that transform the world: ancestral wisdom, justice, and collective courage.** From the Amazon rainforest to the fields of Granada, from Indigenous voices to young girls already leading the future, we discover that true change begins when roots and vision come together:

- Voice of the forest – Nemonte Nenquimo and the Ceibo Alliance defend life from the heart of the Amazon.
- Soil in regeneration – biochar turns waste into fertility and hope in southern Spain.
- They are changing the world – women and girls lead regeneration efforts across Africa, India, and the Philippines.
- Education as transformation – with Norah Magero and Jane Goodall as beacons of awareness and action.
- Justice taking root – ecology, culture, and dignity through the voices of Nemonte Nenquimo and Christiana Figueres.
